OCTOBER 2017

The consumer price index increased by 0.1 percent for the month of October 2017. The “All Items” index was registered as 108.5 percent for the month of October compared to 108.4 for the month of September. The “point-to-point” inflation rate stood at 2.3 percent.

Six (6) groups recorded increases during the month, “Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels” (0.9%), “Health” (0.9%), “Recreation and Culture” (0.7%), “Clothing and Footwear” (0.2%), “Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages” (0.1%) and “Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance” (0.1%). One (1) group recorded a decrease for the period, “Transport” (2.6%), while five (5) groups remained unchanged, “Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics”, “Communication”, “Education”, “Restaurants and Hotels” and “Miscellaneous Goods and Services.

The 0.9 percent increase in the group index for “Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels” is due mainly to a 5.6 percent increase in the cost of electricity. This increase resulted from a change in the fuel surcharge rate which grew from 25.15 cents per kilowatt hour in September to 29.34 cents per kilowatt hour in October 2017.

The “Health” index increased by 0.9 percent due to higher price for dental services, which grew by 6.1 percent. Whereas, the “Recreation and Culture” index grew by 0.7 percent due to a 25.0 percent increase in the price of vaccination for pets.

The “Clothing and Footwear” index grew by 0.2 percent due mainly to an increase of 50.0 percent in the price of a pair of sneakers for boys. Similarly, the “Furnishing, Household Equipment and

Household Maintenance” group index increased by 0.1 percent due mainly to an increase of 3.2 percent in the price of carbon batteries.

The 0.1 percent increase in the “Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages” index is due to an increase in the prices of several food items, cucumbers (26.9%), evaporated milk (13.5%), cabbage (12.7%), lentils (11.6%), condensed milk (11.1%), tomatoes (10.7%), pepper sauce (8.6%), green seasoning (7.2%), ice cream (6.6%), whole chicken (3.6%).

Lower prices for passenger airfare from St Vincent and the Grenadines to several destinations, which includes, Barbados (44.3%), St. Lucia (40.2%), Trinidad and Tobago (10.0%) and London (5.1%) contributed to the 2.6 percent decline in the “Transport” index.

Chart 1. COICOP Groups Percentage Change for October 2017

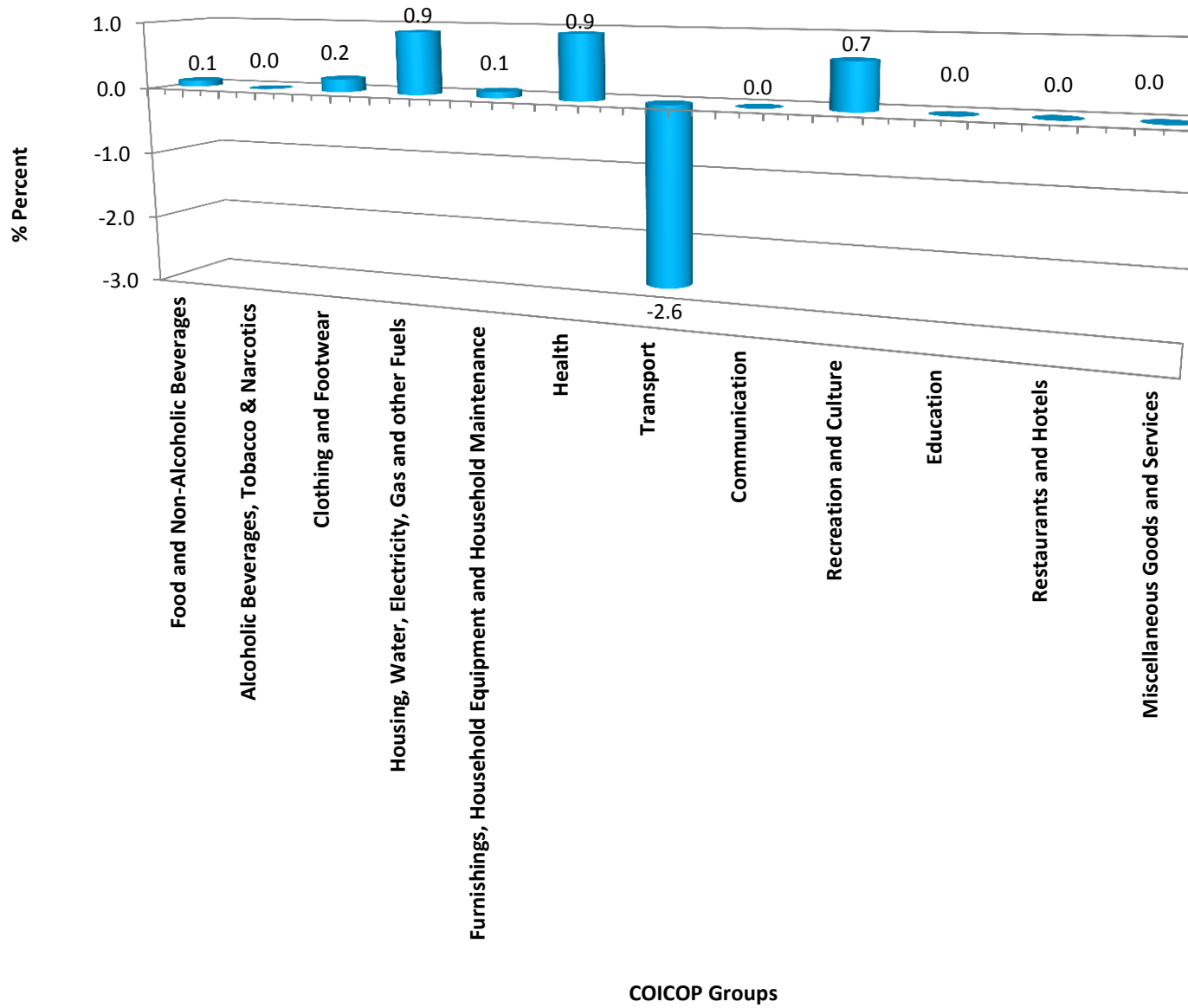
