AUGUST 2019

The consumer price index remained unchanged during the month of August 2019, compared to a 0.2 percent increase for the month of July 2019. *(See table 3)*.

The "All Items" index was recorded at 111.8 for the months of July and August 2019 respectively. Four (4) groups recorded increases during the month namely, "Transport" (1.3%), "Recreation and Culture" (0.8%), "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics" (0.5%) and "Health" (0.1%). One (1) group decreased for the month, "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.9%). Seven (7) groups remained unchanged, "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages", "Clothing and Footwear", "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance", "Communication", "Education", "Hotels and Restaurants" and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services". *(See table 3)*.

The index for "Transport" grew by 1.3 percent as a result of increases in the price for passenger airfares from St. Vincent and the Grenadines to a few destinations, namely, Toronto-Canada (33.2%) and London-United Kingdom (24.2%). A rise in the cost of gasoline (7.9%) and diesel (1.3%) also accounted for the growth in this index.

Higher prices for cat food (11.7%) and dog food (7.6%) were responsible for the 0.8 percent increase in the group index for "Recreation and Culture".

Meanwhile, there was a 0.5 percent increase in the index for "Alcoholic Beverages, Narcotics & Tobacco" group. This was mainly on account of increases in ginger wine (7.3%), black wine (3.1%) and imported white rum (3.1%).

The "Health" index grew by 0.1 percent on account of a rise in the cost of dental care services (8.3 percent).

"Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" index fell by 0.9 percent due to a reduction in the cost of cooking gas; 100lb cylinder (4.3%), 25lb cylinder (4.3%) and 20lb cylinder (4.1%) and a 3.7 percent reduction in the cost of electricity.

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 0.9 percent for the month of August 2019 compared to 2.2 percent for August 2018. The groups that accounted for the largest increases during the period were "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics (3.5%), "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (1.7%), "Transport" (1.3%), "Hotels and Restaurants" (1.2%) and "Food and Alcoholic Beverages" (1.1%), (*See table 3*).

The consumer price index remained unchanged for the month of August 2019. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 0.9 percent due to relative price changes during the month of August 2019 compared with 2.2 percent for the same period in the previous year.




Chart 1. COICOP Groups Percentage Change for August 2019
