

SEPTEMBER 2019

During the month of September 2019, the consumer price index recorded a decrease of 0.3 percent in contrast to remaining unchanged during the month of August 2019. (see table 3).

The "All Items" index was recorded at 111.5 compared to 111.8 for the month of August 2019. Six (6) groups recorded increases during the month, namely, "Education" (1.8%), "Health" (0.5%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.4%), "Hotels and Restaurants" (0.4%), "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.3%) and "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics" (0.1%). The group "Transport" was the sole group to record a decrease during the month (2.8%). Five (5) groups remained unchanged, "Clothing and Footwear", "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels", "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance", "Communication" and "Recreation and Culture". (See table 3).

Higher prices for tuition fees at the following campuses, namely, St. Augustine U.W.I. (8.1%) and Mona U.W.I. (2.4%) led to the 1.8 percent increase in the "Education' index.

"Health" grew by 0.5 percent on account of a rise in the price of a drug for the treatment of diabetes (15.4%).

The upward movement of 0.4 percent in the group index for "Food and Non- Alcoholic Beverages" was due to an increase in the prices of a few commodities, namely, chicken neck (35.5%), pig snout (11.1%), turkey neck (7.5%), evaporated milk (2.9%), codfish (2.1%) and other cereal (0.3%).

Higher prices for disposable diapers (10.1%), comb (10.0%), toothpaste (5.9%), antibacterial soap (3.2%), sanitary napkin (2.5%) and toilet soap (2.2%) were responsible for the 0.3 percent increase in the index for "Miscellaneous Goods and Services".

Meanwhile, there was a 0.1 percent increase in the index for "Alcoholic Beverages, Narcotics & Tobacco" group. This was mainly on account of an increase in the prices for brandy (0.7%) and whiskey (0.5%).

The "Transport" index fell by 2.8 percent as a result of a decrease in the prices for passenger airfares from St. Vincent and the Grenadines to a few destinations, namely, Toronto (55.3%), London (23.5%), Trinidad and Tobago (18.7%), St. Lucia (7.4%) and New York (6.0%).

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 0.5 percent for the month of September 2019 compared to 2.3 percent for September 2018. The groups that accounted for the largest increases during the period were "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics (3.0%), "Education" (1.8%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (1.6%), "Hotels and Restaurants" (1.6%) and "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (1.5%), (*See table 3*).

The consumer price index decreased by 0.3 percent for the month of September 2019. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 0.5 percent due to relative price changes during the month of September 2019 compared with the same period in the previous year.


