


# CONSUMER PRICE INDEX MONTHLY STATISTICAL BULLETIN

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### **DECEMBER 2019**

During the month of December 2019, the consumer price index recorded a decrease of 0.5 percent in contrast to an increase of 0.4 percent for the month of November 2019 (see table 3).

The "All Items" index was recorded at 111.3 for the month of December compared to 111.9 for the month of November 2019. Three (3) groups recorded decreases during the month, namely, "Transport" (2.5%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.9%) and "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.1%). Meanwhile, three (3) groups recorded increases for the month, "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.4%), "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" (0.3%) and "Furnishing, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.1%). Six (6) groups remained unchanged, "Clothing and Footwear", "Health", "Communication", "Recreation and Culture", "Education" and "Restaurants and Hotels" (see table 3).

Lower passenger airfares from St. Vincent and the Grenadines to several destinations: New York (39.8%), Barbados (24.4%), London (14.0%), Trinidad and Tobago (11.5%), St. Lucia (8.9%) and Toronto (8.8%) led to the decline in the "Transport" index (*see table 1*).

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" index fell by 0.9 percent due to a reduction in the price of cooking gas; 100lb cylinder (3.7%), 25lb cylinder (3.7%) and 20lb cylinder (3.5%) and a 4.7 percent reduction in the cost of electricity.

Similarly, the group index for "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" decreased by 0.1 percent due to lower prices for several items, namely, chicken leg quarters (28.2%), chicken neck (23.8%), garlic - loose (21.6%), christophene (4.3%), eggs (1.6%), whole chicken (1.3%) and whole wheat flour (0.4%).

The "Miscellaneous Goods & Services" group index increased by 0.4 percent which was on account of higher prices for disposable diapers (5.6%), mouthwash (7.2%), sanitary napkins (7.2%) and toothpaste (1.2%).

"Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" index increased by 0.3 percent as a result of higher prices for items such as ginger wine (3.3%), brandy (1.2%), local black wine (1.1%) and local white rum (0.5%).

Meanwhile, the increase of 0.1 percent in the "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" group index was due to higher prices for candles (0.5%) and clothes pegs (0.2%) (see table 1).

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 0.5 percent. The groups that accounted for the largest increases during the period are, "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics" (3.4%), "Restaurants and Hotels" (2.1%), "Furnishing, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (2.0%), "Education" (1.8%) and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (1.5%). The groups "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" and "Health" recorded declines of (1.0%) and (0.8%) respectively (*see table 3*).


The average price of the basket fell by 0.5 percent for the month of December 2019 compared to November 2019 but was 0.5 percent less costly than December 2018.

### **REVIEW OF 2019**

A review of the Consumer Price Index for the year 2019 showed that the annual average "point-to-point" inflation rate was 0.9 percent compared to 2.3 percent for the year 2018 (see table 9). The accumulated inflation rate for the end of 2019 was recorded at negative 0.5 percent in contrast to 1.4 percent for the year 2018 (see table 8). The average "All Items" index was recorded at 111.4 compared to 110.4 for 2018 (see table 6).

During the year, positive values were recorded for the point-to-point inflation rates. The months of June, August and November recorded inflation rates of 0.9 percent. The lowest inflation rate of 0.5 percent was recorded for the months of May, September, October and December while the highest rate of 1.6 percent was recorded for January (*see table 9*).

The monthly inflation rates fluctuated throughout the year with the lowest rate registering at negative 0.5 percent in December and the highest of 0.5 percent for the months of January, April and June (*see table 7*).

The average "All Items" index moved from 111.4 in January to 111.3 in December. The highest level for the year was recorded in the month of November (111.9) while the lowest was recorded in February (110.9). The greatest movement between the months was 0.6 points which occurred between May to June and November to December (*see table 6*).

Eight (8) groups recorded increases for the year, "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" (3.4%), "Restaurants and Hotels" (2.1%), "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (2.0%), "Education" (1.8%), "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (1.5%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.9%), "Transport" (0.9%) and "Clothing and Footwear" (0.1%). Meanwhile, two (2) groups recorded decreases, "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (1.0%) and Health" (0.8%). Two (2) groups remained unchanged, "Communication" and "Recreation and Culture" (see table 3).

"Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" group index recorded growth of 3.4 percent due mainly to higher prices for; ginger wine (13.0%), whiskey (7.5%), red rum (5.8%), local rum (4.7%), white wine (4.1%) and red wine (3.0%) (see table 10.2).

"Restaurant and Hotels" group recorded a growth of 2.1 percent due to increased cost for school meals, namely, chicken lunch (25.0%), bread and chicken (4.5%) pizza (3.6%), other restaurant meals such as mutton lunch (3.1%) and chicken roti (1.1%), Halls of residence fees at Mona (8.0%), St. Augustine (3.9%) and Cave Hill (0.7%) (see table 10.4).

The group index for "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" grew by 2.0 percent. This growth was on account of an increase for several items which include, gas stove (27.2%), matches (20.7%), dining set (14.0%), refrigerator (12.0%), dressing table (5.7%) and air freshener (5.3%) (see table 10.2).

Higher cost for primary school fees (8.8%), tuition fees for foreign education tertiary education Mona (1.6%) and St. Augustine (0.8%) resulted in a 1.8 percent rise in the "Education" index (see table 10.4).

The "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" group index increased by 1.5 percent on account of higher prices for hair relaxers (18.5%), body lotion (11.1%), combs (7.7%), hair grease (6.3%), toothpaste (5.3%), disposable diapers (5.0%) and wedding band for women (3.5%) (see table 10.4).

"Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" group index grew by 0.9 percent. This upward movement was due to higher prices for several food items, namely, barbecue sauce (40.6%), canned mix vegetables (21.4%), sweet pepper (20.8%), string beans (19.6%), ground cinnamon (17.1%), chicken sausage (17.0%), cabbage (16.0%), yeast (14.7%) and packaged whole wheat flour (10.3%)(see table 10.1).

The 0.9 percent growth in the "Transport" index was as a result of higher prices for diesel (12.4%), pick-up truck tyres (9.4%), engine coolant (4.1%), petrol (1.5%) and increased cost for passenger airfare from St Vincent to Mustique (18.2) and St. Vincent and the Grenadines to New York (8.4%), Barbados (6.1%) and London (1.5%) (*see table 10.3*).

Meanwhile, the increase of 0.1 percent in the group "Clothing and Footwear" was due to a increase in the prices of textiles material – Jacquard cotton (15.4%) and wool polystripe suiting (8.5%), bra (15.8%), vest (12.3%) and school blouse (6.9%) (see table 10.2).

A downward movement of 1.0 percent was recorded for the group index "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" due mainly to a lower price for cooking gas (4.4%)(see table 10.2).

The 0.8 percent decline in the "Health" index was on account of a decrease in the price of a drug that is used for the treatment of cancer (17.8%) and diabetes (12.7%), pain relievers (4.9%) and laxatives (1.8%) (see table 10.3).



Chart 2: Monthly All Items Index, January to December 2018 - 2019



Chart 3: Monthly Rate of Inflation, January to December 2018 - 2019



Chart 4: Accumulated Inflation, January to December 2018 - 2019



Chart 5: Point to Point Rate of Inflation, January to December 2018 - 2019


