

JULY 2020

The consumer price index recorded a decline of 0.6 percent for the month of July 2020, compared to an increase of 0.2 percent for the month of June 2020 (*See table 3*).

During the month of July 2020, the “All Items” index was recorded at 110.0, compared to 110.7 for the month of June 2020. Four (4) groups recorded increases during the month, “Health” (0.3%), “Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages” (0.2%), “Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics” (0.2%) and “Miscellaneous Goods and Services” (0.2%).

Two (2) groups recorded decreases during the period, “Transport” (1.6%) and “Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels” (1.5%).

Six (6) groups remained unchanged “Clothing and Footwear” , “Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance”, “Communication”, “Recreation and Culture”, “Education” and “Hotels and Restaurants” (*See table 3*).

The “Health” group index recorded the largest increase of 0.3 percent. This was on account of a 9.5 percent higher price for drugs for hypertension.

“Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics” group index grew by 0.2 percent due to a rise in the cost of red whiskey (4.4%) and cigarettes (1.3%).

Similarly, the “Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages” group index recorded a 0.2 percent increase as a result of higher prices for a number of items namely; chive (25.4%), tomatoes

(20.3%), pineapple juice (5.7%), luncheon meat (4.0%), black-eyed peas (3.9%), watermelon (2.1%), oats cereal (2.0%), english potatoes (1.5%) and brown sugar (1.2%).

“Miscellaneous Goods and Services” group index registered a 0.2 percent upward movement due to an increase in the price for toothpaste (1.8%) and antibacterial soap (1.0%).

The “Transport” group index registered the largest decline of 1.6 percent on account of a fall in the price of petrol (8.1%) and diesel (8.0%). Similarly, the “Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels” group index fell by 1.5 percent as a result of a 7.7 percent decrease in the cost of electricity and also lower prices for LPG cooking gas 100lb (3.5%), 25lb (3.2%) and 20lb (3.0%).

Meanwhile, the point-to-point inflation rate stood at negative 1.6 percent for the month of July 2020 compared to 1.0 percent for July 2019. The groups that accounted for the largest decreases during the period were “Transport” (7.6%), “Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels” (4.4%) and “Clothing and Footwear” (0.5%) (See table 3).

The consumer price index decreased by 0.6 percent for July 2020. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at negative 1.6 percent due to relative price changes during the month of July 2020 compared with the same period in the previous year.

Chart 1. COICOP Groups Percentage Change for July 2020


