#### AUGUST 2020

The consumer price index recorded an increase of 0.3 percent for the month of August 2020 compared to a decline of 0.6 percent for the month of July 2020, *(See table 3).* 

During the month of August 2020, the "All Items" index was recorded at 110.3, compared to 110.0 for the month of July 2020. Four (4) groups recorded increases during the month, "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.6%), "Transport" (0.6%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.4%) and "Recreation and Culture" (0.3%). Three (3) groups recorded decreases during the period, "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.3%), "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" (0.1%) and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.1%). Five (5) groups remained unchanged, "Clothing and Footwear", "Health", "Communication", "Education" and "Hotels and Restaurants".(*See table 3*).

The group index for "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" recorded an increase of 0.6 percent. This was on account of a rise in the prices of locally produced food items, which include cabbage (24.8%), string beans (20.2%), sweet potatoes (16.1%), eddoes (15.4%), dasheens (13.1%), tannias (12.7%) and eggs (10.3%).

The "Transport" group index grew by 0.6 percent as a result of a 5.1 percent rise in the price for gasoline. Similarly, the "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" index grew by 0.4 percent on account of a 2.1 percent increase in the cost for electricity "Recreation and Culture" group index rose by 0.3 percent as a result of an increase of 19.8 percent in the price of plant food.

The group index for "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Appliances" fell by 0.3 percent on account of an 8.0 percent decrease in the price of matches.

"Miscellaneous Goods and Services" group index decreased by 0.1 percent due to a 0.5 percent reduction in the price of a toilet soap. Similarly, the 0.1 percent decline in the "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" index is due to lower prices for stout (0.5%) and beer (0.8%).

Meanwhile, the point-to-point inflation rate stood at negative 1.3 percent for the month of August 2020 compared to 0.9 percent for August 2019. The groups that accounted for the largest increases during the period were "Hotels and Restaurants" (3.8%), "Health" (3.5%), "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (2.2%) and "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (2.0%), (See table 3).

The consumer price index increased by 0.3 percent for August 2020. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at negative 1.3 percent due to relative price changes during the month of August 2020 compared with the same period in the previous year.


