MARCH 2021

The consumer price index recorded an increase of 0.5 percent for the month of March 2021, compared to an increase of 0.3 percent for the month of February 2021 (see table 3).

During the month of March 2021, the "All Items" index was recorded at 111.4 compared to 110.8 for the month of February 2021. Four (4) groups recorded increases during the month, namely, "Transport" (1.9%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.9%), "Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages" (0.2%) and "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.1%). One (1) group recorded a decrease for the month, "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics" (0.1%). Seven groups remained unchanged, "Clothing and Footwear", "Health", "Communication", "Recreation and Culture", "Education", "Hotels and Restaurants" and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services".

The "Transport" index grew by 1.9 percent due to an increase in the prices for diesel fuel (16.4%) and petrol, unleaded (7.1%).

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" group index recorded an increase of 0.9 percent. This was on account of an increase in the prices of galvanise sheets (14.2%), electricity (6.3%) and lumber - dressed (2.1%).

Similarly, the "Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages" group index recorded a 0.2 percent increase as a result of higher prices for a number of food items namely; canned fruit, sliced pineapple (16.8%), pig tail, salted (13.7%), cucumber (11.1%), red kidney bean - loose (11.1%), other cereal (10.0%), cauliflower (5.1%), pig snout (4.6%), eggs (4.6%), mutton (3.9%), chicken - neck (3.5%), turkey (2.1%), chicken - leg quarters (1.8%) and canned fish (1.7%).

"Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" grew by 0.1 percent due mainly to an increase in the price of toilet paper (33.3%).

The group index for "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" declined by 0.1 percent due to a decrease in the prices of stout - imported (1.3%) and beer - imported (0.2%).

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at negative 0.1 percent for the month of March 2021 compared to 0.5 percent for March 2020. The groups that accounted for the largest decreases during the period were, "Education" (2.4%), "Transport" (1.5%), "Housing, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (1.3%) (*See table 3*).

The consumer price index increased by 0.5 percent for March 2021. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at negative 0.1 percent due to relative price changes during the month of March 2021 compared with the same period in the previous year.


