## **MAY 2021**

The consumer price index recorded a decrease of 0.1 percent for the month of May 2021, compared to an increase of 0.5 percent for the month of April 2021 (see table 3).

During the month of May 2021, the "All Items" index was recorded at 111.9 compared to 112.0 for the month of April 2021. Four (4) groups recorded increases during the month, namely, "Health" (0.5%), "Transport" (0.2%), "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" (0.1%) and "Recreation and Culture" (0.1%). Three (3) groups recorded decrease for the month, "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.5%), "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.1%) and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.1%). Five (5) groups remained unchanged, namely, "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages", "Clothing and Footwear", "Communication", "Education" and "Hotels and Restaurants".

"Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" group index recorded a decrease of 0.5 percent. This was on account of a fall in the price of a french door (1.7%) and the cost of electricity (3.4%).

The 0.1 percent decline in the "Furnishing, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" is due to lower prices for disinfectant (3.8%), washing soap (1.6%), toilet paper (0.7%) and washing powder (0.6%).

Lower prices for an antibacterial soap (5.5%) and toilet soap (2.3%) were responsible for the 0.1 percent decrease in the group index for "Miscellaneous Goods and Services".

The index for "Health" increased by 0.5 percent on account of a 27.8 percent rise in the price of the drugs that is used for the treatment of hypertension.

Similarly, the index for "Transport" index grew by 0.2 percent due to an increase in the price for truck tyres (18.3%) and motor car tyres (13.9%).

The group index for "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" increased by 0.1 percent due to higher prices for imported rum (1.3%) and local beer (0.8%).

Higher prices for an english textbook (6.1%) and exercise book (1.0%) were responsible for the 0.1 percent increase in the group index for "Recreation and Culture".

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 1.3 percent for the month of May 2021 compared to negative 0.5 percent for May 2020. The groups that accounted for the largest increase during the period were, "Health" (4.2%), "Hotels and Restaurants" (2.2%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (1.8%) and "Transport" (1.8%) (See table 3).

The consumer price index decreased by 0.1 percent for May 2021. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 1.3 percent due to relative price changes during the month of May 2021 compared with the same period in the previous year.


