

OCTOBER 2021

The consumer price index recorded an increase of 0.2 percent for the month of October 2021 compared to 0.1 percent for the month of September 2021 (*see table 3*).

During the month, the "All Items" index was recorded at 113.4 compared to 113.2 for September 2021. Six (6) groups recorded increases, namely; "Transport" (0.4%), "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics" (0.4%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.3%), "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.2%), "Recreation and Culture" (0.2%) and "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.1%). One (1) group recorded a decrease; "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.1%). Five (5) groups remained unchanged; "Clothing and Footwear", "Health", "Communication", "Education" and "Hotels and Restaurants".

The "Transport" index grew by 0.4 percent on account of a 1.8 percent increase in the price of petrol. Similarly, the 0.4 percent growth in the group index for "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics, was due mainly to an increase of 5.9 percent in the price of a bottle of whiskey.

"Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" increase by 0.3 percent due mainly to a 1.9 percent increase in the price of electricity. This higher price is as a result of an increase in the fuel surcharge rate which moved from 36.93 cents per kilowatt hour in September 2021 to 38.57 cents per kilowatt hour in October 2021.

The group index for "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" grew by 0.2 percent due mainly to a 7.6 percent increase in the price of an electric bulb and 5.7 percent in the price of a bottle of dishwashing liquid. Meanwhile, the 0.2 percent increase in the "Recreation and Culture" index is due to a 5.2 percent increase in the price of a can of dog food.

"Food and Non-Alcoholic" group index grew by 0.1 percent on account of an increase in the prices of several foods items which include; canned mixed vegetables (11.9%), corned beef

(11.3%), sliced pineapple (9.0%), sweet peppers (8.5%), pumpkins (8.1%) and broccoli (5.6%).

The "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" group recorded a decline of 0.1 percent as a result of a 1.9 percent fall in the price of an antibacterial soap.

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 2.8 percent for October 2021 compared to negative 1.1 percent for October 2020. The groups that accounted for the largest increases during the period were: "Transport" (9.0%), "Housing, Water, Electricity and Other Fuels" (4.2%) and "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (2.4%), (see table 3).

The consumer price index increased by 0.2 percent for October 2021. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 2.8 percent due to relative price changes during the month of October 2021 compared with the same period in the previous year.


