

SEPTEMBER 2020

The consumer price index recorded a decline of 0.1 percent for the month of September 2020 compared to an increase of 0.3 percent for the month of August 2020 *(See table 3)*.

During the month of September 2020, the "All Items" index was recorded at 110.2 compared to 110.3 for the month of August 2020. Five (5) groups recorded increases during the month, "Transport" (1.2%), "Recreation and Culture" (0.2%), "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.1%), "Hotels and Restaurants" (0.1%) and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.1%). Three (3) groups recorded decreases during the period, "Education" (2.4%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.5%) and "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.3%). Four (4) groups remained unchanged, "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics", "Clothing and Footwear", "Health" and "Communication" (See table 3).

"Transport" group index recorded the largest increase of 1.2 percent due to higher costs for passenger airfares from St. Vincent and the Grenadines to a few destinations, namely, London (57.4%) and Toronto (9.9%).

The index for the group "Recreation and Culture" grew by 0.2 percent on account of an increase in the price of pencils (16.0%).

Similarly, the "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" group index recorded a 0.1 percent increase as a result of higher prices for matches (2.0%) and candles (0.6%).

The increase of 0.1 percent in the "Hotels and Restaurants" index resulted from a rise in the price of a mutton lunch (2.6%).

"Miscellaneous Goods and Services" group index increased by 0.1 percent due to a rise in prices of toothpaste (0.9%) and combs (0.4%).

The "Education" group index recorded the largest decline of 2.4 percent on account of lower tuition fees at UWI - St. Augustine (12.3%) and UWI - Mona Campus (1.2%).

Similarly, the "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" group index fell by 0.5 percent as a result of a 2.7 percent decrease in the cost of electricity.

"Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" group index recorded a decrease of 0.3 percent as a result of lower prices for a number of items including, cucumber (21.0%), sweet pepper (16.0%), turkey wings (8.8%), carrots (8.6%), canned fish - tuna (7.9%), pig feet - frozen (7.3%), chicken - leg quarters (3.9%), condensed milk (2.0%), corn flakes (1.1%) and corned beef (1.1%).

Meanwhile, the point-to-point inflation rate stood at negative 1.2 percent for the month of September 2020 compared to 0.5 percent for September 2019. The groups that accounted for the largest increases during the period were, "Hotels and Restaurants" (3.5%), "Health" (3.1%), "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (2.0%) and "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (1.3%) (See table 3).

The consumer price index decreased by 0.1 percent for September 2020. The point-topoint inflation rate stood at negative 1.2 percent due to relative price changes during the month of September 2020 compared with the same period in the previous year.


