

April 2022

The consumer price index recorded an increase of 1.3 percent for the month April 2022 compared to 0.5 for the month of March 2022, (see table 3).

During the month of April, the "All Items" index was recorded at 116.9 compared to 115.4 for the month of March 2022. Seven (7) groups recorded increases during the month, namely; "Hotels and Restaurants" (8.1%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (1.7%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (1.7%), "Health" (1.4%), "Transport" (1.2%), "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.6%) and "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.4%). Three (3) groups recorded decreased for the month, "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics (0.3%), "Clothing and Footwear" (0.1%) and "Recreation and Culture" (0.1%). Two groups remained unchanged, "Communication", and "Education", (See table 3).

The 8.1 percent growth in the index for "Hotels and Restaurants" was due to increases in the prices for fruit juice (19.6%), fish lunch (15.5%), chicken roti (11.9%), chicken lunch (11.8%), and beef roti (11.8%).

"Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages" increased by 1.7 percent due to higher prices for several food items, which included: pineapple (115.0%), cucumber (40.4%), powdered milk, skimmed (17.3%), corned beef (13.0%), lentils (12.4%) and flour (10.3%).

The group index for "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" grew by 1.7 percent due mainly to an increase of 9.3 percent in the price of electricity. This was on account of an increase in the fuel surcharge rate which moved from 47.38 cents per kilowatt hour for the month of March 2022 to 56.47 cents per kilowatt hour for the month of April 2022.

Similarly, the index for "Transport" increased by 1.7 percent due to an increase in the price of diesel (7.8%) and petrol (3.6%).

The "Health" index rose by 1.4 percent on account of an increase in the prices of drugs that are being used for the treatment of cancer (60.0%) and hypertension (41.4%).

The group index for "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" grew by 0.6% due mainly to higher prices for braiding hair (10.9%), toilet soap (10.8%) and roll on (8.8%).

The 0.4 percent growth in the group index for "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" was mainly a result of an increase in the prices for mattress (22.0%) and living room set (8.9%).

Meanwhile, the 0.3 percent decline in the index for "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" was attributed to lower prices for an imported beer (19.5%), whiskey (5.7%) and stout (1.8%).

"Clothing and Footwear" declined by 0.1 percent due mainly to a decrease of 15.4 percent in the price of textile material – tetrix.

Similarly, the index for "Recreation and Culture" declined by 0.1 percent on account of a reduction in the price of notebook (14.4%) and mathematics textbook (3.9%).

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 4.4 percent for the month of April 2022 compared to 0.4 percent for April 2021. The groups that accounted for the largest increases during the period were, "Hotels and Restaurants" (10.5%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (7.8%), "Transport" (6.7%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (5.0%) and "Health" (4.5%), (See table 3).

The consumer price index increased by 1.3 percent for April 2022. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 4.4 due to relative price changes during the month of April 2022 compared with the same period in the previous year.


