


CONSUMER PRICE INDEX MONTHLY STATISTICAL BULLETIN

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August 2022

The consumer price index recorded an increase of 0.7 percent for the month August 2022 compared to 0.9 percent for the month of July 2022, (see table 3).

During the month of August 2022, the "All Items" index was recorded at 120.6 compared to 119.8 for the month of July 2022. Seven (7) groups recorded increases during the month, namely; "Transport" (2.1%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (2.0%), "Clothing and Footwear" (0.8%), "Recreation and Culture" (0.5%), Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance (0.3%), "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics (0.1%) and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.1%). The only group that recorded a decline was "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.4%). Four (4) groups remained unchanged, "Health", "Communication", "Education" and "Hotels and Restaurants", (*See table 3*).

The 2.1 percent growth in the "Transport" index was on account of an increase in the prices for petrol (10.7%) and diesel fuel (7.0%).

The group index for "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" grew by 2.0 percent due mainly to higher prices for several food items, which included; patties (35.7%), tomatoes (35.3%), chive (20.7%), small loaf – white (20.2%), chicken luncheon meat (18.8%), garlic (16.3%), small whole wheat loaf (14.7%), large whole wheat loaf (14.5%), powdered milk – full cream (11.0%) and whole wheat flour (10.2%).

The 0.8% increase in the index for "Clothing and Footwear" was due mainly to an increase in the price of textile material –tetrex (18.3%) and a pair of socks (11.1%).

"Recreation and Culture" recorded growth of 0.5 percent due to an increase in the price of pet food. There was a 34.0 percent increase in the price of a tin of cat food and 16.7 percent for a tin of dog food.

The group index for "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" grew by 0.3 percent due mainly to a higher price for a florescent light tube (6.4%) and a cake of washing soap (2.4%).

The index for "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" grew by 0.1 percent due to a 2.7% increase in the price of a bottle of whiskey. Similarly, the 0.1 percent increase in the index for "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" is due mainly to a 1.8% increase in the price of a bottle of roll on.

Meanwhile, the group index for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" recorded a decline of 0.4 percent due to a reduction of 3.5 percent in the cost of electricity. This reduction resulted from a lower fuel surcharge rate of 64.63 cents per Kilowatt hour for the month of August 2022 compared to 68.33 cents for the month of July 2022.

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 6.6 percent for the month of August 2022 compared to 2.5 percent for August 2021. The groups that accounted for the largest increases during the period were, "Hotels and Restaurants" (12.1%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (12.0%), "Transport" (10.1%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (6.4%) and "Health" (5.4%) (See table 3).

The consumer price index increased by 0.7 percent for August 2022. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 6.6 due to relative price changes during the month of August 2022 compared with the same period in the previous year.


