

JANUARY 2024

The consumer price index recorded an increase of 0.6 percent for the month of January 2024, after being unchanged for the month of December 2023 (see table 3).

During the month of January 2024, the "All Items" index was recorded at 127.2 compared to 126.5 for the month of December 2023. Seven (7) groups recorded an increase during the month namely; "Transport" (2.9%), "Clothing and Footwear" (1.9%), "Recreation and Culture" (1.8%), "Health" (1.3%), "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" (0.9%), "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.6%) and "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.3%). Three (3) groups recorded decreases during the month; "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (1.4%), "Hotels and Restaurants" (1.0%) and "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.1%). Two (2) groups remained unchanged; "Communication" and "Education".

The "Transport" index increased by 2.9 percent as a result of increase in the price of passenger airfare from St. Vincent and the Grenadines to Toronto (50.9%), Miami (12.7%), Barbados (5.1%), tyres (47.2%) and used cars (13.6%).

Higher prices for a television (8.1%), cat food (7.3%) and dog food (4.7%) were responsible for the 1.8 percent increase in the group index for "Recreation and Culture".

The index for "Health" increased by 1.3 percent due to increases in the price of antiinflammatory pain medication (29.0%), drugs for diabetes (20.0%) and a chest x-ray (6.7%).

The group index for "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" increased by 0.9 percent due to higher prices for tequila (23.1%), Irish cream (9.2%), local wine (8.9%) and cigarettes (8.0%).

"Clothing and Footwear" increased by 1.9 percent as a result of increase in the prices for women's dress shoes (40.9%), men's t-shirt (30.1%) and women's blouse (20.4%) and brassiere (13.6%).

The 0.6 percent increase in the group index for "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" resulted from an increase in the price for comprehensive car insurance (14.5%), deodorant (18.3%), mouthwash (11.0%) and third-party car insurance (2.7%).

"Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" group index recorded a 0.3 percent increase as a result of higher prices for a number of items namely; spaghetti (24.1%), green pigeon peas (23.6%), ripe plantains (22.3%), whole kernel corn (16.4%), tin sausage (11.4%), corned beef (10.1%), sardine (10.0%), chicken wings (3.5%), loose garlic (3.2%) and turkey wings (1.9%).

Meanwhile, "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" group index declined by 1.4 percent on account of a decrease in the price of a queen size sheet set (26.9%, dinner plates (11.0%) and dinner forks (6.5%).

The 1.0 percent decrease in "Hotels and Restaurants" group index was due to a decrease in the price for accommodation services at overseas universities Mona (27.3%) and St. Augustine (8.0%).

The "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" group index recorded a decrease of 0.1 percent due mainly to a decrease in the price of electricity (0.3%).

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 4.8 percent for the month of January 2024 compared to 5.8 percent for January 2023. The groups that accounted for the largest increases during the period were, "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (9.0%), "Clothing and Footwear" (8.9%), "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (7.1%), "Recreation and Culture" (5.9%) and "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (4.8%). The consumer price index decreased by 0.6 percent for January 2024. The point-topoint inflation rate stood at 4.8 due to relative price changes during the month of January 2024 compared with the same period in the previous year.


