MAY 2024

The consumer price index increased by 0.2 percent for the month of May 2024 compared to 0.9 percent for the month of April 2024 (*see table 3*).

During the month of May 2024, the "All Items" index was recorded at 129.1 in comparison to 128.9 for the month of April 2024. Five (5) groups recorded an increase during the month namely; "Hotels and Restaurants" (3.2%), "Transport" (2.3%), "Clothing & Footwear" (0.4%) "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics" (0.1%) and "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.1%). Five (5) groups recorded a decrease during the period; "Recreation and Culture" (0.9%), "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.5%) "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.4%) "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.4%) and "Health" (0.3%). Two groups remained unchanged "Communication" and "Education" (see table 3).

The group index for "Hotels and Restaurants" increased by 3.2 percent due to higher prices for chicken and fries meal (22.4 %) and a chicken sandwich (20.0%).

The index for the group "Transport" recorded a 2.3 percent upward movement as a result of increases in the prices for passenger airfare from St. Vincent and the Grenadines to London (36.9%), Grenada (28.2%), Trinidad and Tobago (22.0%), drivers' license (25.0%) and vehicular license; exceeding 3000lbs (14.8%), not exceeding 2000lbs (12.8%).

The "Clothing and Footwear" group index registered an increase of 0.4 percent on the account of a rise in the cost of men's T-shirt (33.8%).

The index for the group "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics" grew by 0.1 percent because of an increase in the price of cigarettes (4.8%) and whiskey – black (2.1%).

Similarly, the index for the group "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" increased by 0.1 due to a rise in the cost of dishwashing liquid (9.5%) and toilet tissue (3.3%).

Meanwhile, the "Recreation and Culture" group index recorded a decrease of 0.9 percent because of lower prices for a tablet computer- 10" (30.2%), laptop computer -8GB (17.7%) and smart television 50" (7.6%).

The index for the group "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" declined by 0.5 percent due to a (4.9%) reduction in the cost of men's deodorant.

Whereas the group index for "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" registered a 0.4 percent downward movement as a result of a lower prices for food items such as; watermelon (20.8%), cabbage – local (16.7%), red seedless grape (12.2%), cucumber (8.1%) and sweet potatoes (5.3%).

Likewise, the "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other fuels" group index fell by 0.4 percent due to a 2.1 percent decline in the cost of electricity.

The index for the group "Health" recorded a 0.3 percent reduction on account of a fall in the cost of spectacles (19.8%).

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 4.4 percent for the month of May 2024 compared to 4.7 percent for May 2023. The groups that represented the largest increases during the period were, "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages (8.7%), "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (7.3%) "Clothing and Footwear" (7.2%), "Hotels and Restaurants" (7.0%) and "Transport" (5.2%)

The consumer price index increased for May 2024. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 4.4 due to relative price changes during the month of May 2024 compared with the same period in the previous year.


