#### August 2024

The Consumer Price Index decreased by 0.6 percent for the month of August 2024 compared to an increase of 0.3 percent for the month of July 2024. (*see table 3*).

During the month of August 2024, the "All Items" Index was registered at 128.6 in comparison to 129.4 for the month of July 2024. Five (5) groups recorded an increase during the period; "Health" (1.2%), "Recreation and Culture" (0.7%), "Transport" (0.4%), "Hotel and Restaurants" (0.2%) and "Clothing and Footwear" (0.1%). Four (4) groups recorded a decrease during the month; "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (3.0%), "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" (0.3%), "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.1%) and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.1%). Three (3) groups remained unchanged; "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages", "Communication" and "Education".

The group index for "Health" increased by 1.2 percent on account of higher prices for drugs for pain (50.0%) and drugs for diabetes (2.2%).

The index for "Recreation and Culture" increased by 0.7 percent due to an increase in the prices for a laptop computer 4GB (12.1%) and a language textbook (10.5%).

The upward movement of 0.4 percent in the group index for "Transport" was due to higher costs for passenger airfare from St Vincent and the Grenadines to: New York, U.S.A (18.7%), Trinidad and Tobago (12.0%) and for new tyres; SUV and pickup truck (12.7%) and (5.9%) respectively.

"Hotels and Restaurants "group index recorded a rise of 0.2 percent as a result of a higher price for a chicken and fries' meal (4.2%).

"Clothing and Footwear" group index increased by 0.1 percent on account of an increase in the price for a men's long sleeve shirt (8.1%).

The index for the group "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" fell by 3.0 percent as a result of a lower cost in the fuel surcharge rate, which moved from 64.51 cents per kilowatt hour for the month of July to 45.94 cents per kilowatt hour for the month of August 2024.

The group index for "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" decreased by 0.3 percent due to a decline in the prices for wine – local (5.3%) and white wine (2.2%).

The "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" group index fell by 0.1 percent because of a decrease in the cost of a gas stove (10.8%) and bathroom tissue (3.2%).

Similarly, the "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" group index recorded a 0.1 percent downward movement on account of a lower price for toothpaste (5.3%).

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 2.7 percent for the month of August 2024 compared to 3.8 percent for the month of August 2023. The groups that represented the largest increases during the period were, "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (7.6%), "Hotels and Restaurants" (6.9%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages (5.5%) and "Clothing and Footwear" (5.1%).

The consumer price index decreased for August 2024. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 2.7 percent due to relative price changes during the month of August 2024 compared with the same period in the previous year.


