

## October 2024

The Consumer Price Index decreased by 0.6 percent for the month of October 2024 compared to an increase of 1.0 percent for the month of September 2024, (*see table 3*).

During the month of October 2024, the "All Items" index was registered at 129.1 in comparison to 129.9 for the month of September 2024. Two (2) groups recorded an increase during the period; "Clothing and Footwear" (1.3%) and "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.1%). Seven (7) groups recorded a decrease during the month; "Transport" (1.6%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (1.3%), "Health (1.0%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.3%), "Recreation and Culture" (0.3%), "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.2%) and "Communication" (0.1%). Three (3) groups remained unchanged; "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics", "Education" and "Hotels and Restaurants".

The upward movement of 1.3 percent in the group index for "Clothing and Footwear" was due to higher prices for a belt (56.3%), long jeans (21.7%) and men's dress shoes (16.9%).

"Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" index increased by 0.1 percent due mainly to an increase in the price for gas stove – 4 burner (8.5%).

The "Transport" index declined by 1.6 percent due to a reduction in the price for petrol (8.2%), diesel fuel (3.4%) and the cost of passenger airfare from St Vincent and the Grenadines to several destinations which included: Barbados (19.2%), Antigua and Barbada (5.4%), Trinidad and Tobago (3.4%) and Miami (3.1%).

The 1.3 percent decrease in the index for "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" resulted from a decrease of 7.2 percent in the cost of electricity. This decline in the cost of electricity is on account of the reduction in the fuel surcharge rate which moved from 59.89 cents per kilowatt hour in September 2024 to 52.01 cents per kilowatt hour for the month of October 2024.

"Health" declined by 1.0 percent due to lower prices for anti-inflammatory medication (22.5%) and drugs used in the treatment of Diabetes (5.1%).

The 0.3 percent decline in the index for "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" is accounted for by lower prices for several food items which included: local tomatoes (13.3%), tinned pigeon peas (8.8%), dasheen (5.2%), tea (5.2%), eggs (3.0%), soyabean oil (2.7%) and chicken back (2.6%).

Similarly, the index for "Recreation and Culture" decreased by 0.3 percent due to a reduction in the prices for an English textbook (12.0%) and a 50" television (4.5%).

"Miscellaneous Goods and Services" declined by 0.2 percent due to lower prices for a bath soap (6.0%) and toothpaste (1.9%).

The index for "Communication" decreased by 0.1 percent due to a 1.1 percent decline in the price for a cell phone.

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 2.3 percent for the month of October 2024 compared to 3.5 percent for the month of October 2023. The groups that represented the largest increases during the period were, "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (6.3%), "Hotels and Restaurants" (6.2%), "Education" (5.6%), "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (5.0%), and "Clothing and Footwear" (3.6%).

The consumer price index decreased for October 2024. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 2.3 percent due to relative price changes during the month of October 2024 compared with the same period in the previous year.


