

## January 2025

The Consumer Price Index increased by 0.4 percent for the month of January 2025 compared to a decrease of 0.4 percent for the month of December 2024. (*see table 3*).

During the month of January 2025, the "All Items" index was registered at 129.6 in comparison to 129.1 for the month of December 2024. Six (6) groups recorded an increase during the period; "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (2.7%), "Hotels and Restaurants" (1.5%), "Health" (1.5%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (1.2%), "Transport" (0.4%) and "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" (0.1%). Four (4) groups recorded a decrease during the month; "Clothing and Footwear" (1.0%), "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.8%), "Recreation and Culture" (0.6%), and "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.1%). Two (2) groups remained unchanged; "Communication" and "Education".

"Miscellaneous Goods and Services" group index increased by 2.7 percent due to higher prices for a basic funeral package (20.7%), mouthwash (12.1%), women's hair treatment (11.8%) and roll-on (10.2%).

The 1.5 percent increase in the group index for "Health" is due to an increase in the price of anti-inflammatory medication (22.4%), spectacles (16.4%) and anti-histamine medication. (11.8%).

Similarly, the index for "Hotels and Restaurants" increased by 1.5 percent due to higher prices for meals at schools and restaurants. The school meals that increased were roti (60.0%) and chicken lunch (14.3%). Meals at restaurant included a sandwich (14.3%), beef roti (7.9%) and pizza (7.3%).

The group index for "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" increased by 1.2 percent on account of a 7.5 increase in the price of electricity. This increase is due to a higher fuel surcharge rate which moved from 43.12 cents per kilowatt hour for the month of December 2024 to 50.25 cents per kilowatt hour for January 2025.

"Transport" grew by 0.4 percent due to increased prices for pickup trucks (35.6%), passenger airfare from St Vincent and the Grenadines to New York, USA (32.1%) and car tires (20.8%).

"Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" group index recorded an increase of 0.1 percent due to an increase of 2.7% for a red wine and 2.6% for a stout.

The index for the group "Clothing and Footwear" decreased by 1.0 percent as result of a decrease in the price for men's neck ties (16.7%), Children panties (14.9%), men's dress shoes (14.5%) and men's long jeans (11.0%).

"Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" declined by 0.8 percent due to lower prices for a mattress (39.5%), a 4-burner gas stove (17.1%) and dinner forks (14.1%).

The 0.6 percent decrease in the group index for "Recreation and Culture" is due to a reduction of 27.4% in the price of a 55" inch television.

The "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" group index decreased by 0.1 percent due to a reduction in the price of several food items which included: tomatoes (28.1%), cabbage (11.7%), corned beef (9.3%), yams (7.9%), small loaf, wholewheat (6.7%), pumpkin (6.4%), eggs (5.8%0 and package rice (5.2%).

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 1.9 percent for the month of January 2025 compared to 4.8 percent for the month of January 2024. The groups that represented the largest increases during the period were, "Hotels and Restaurants" (8.9%), "Education" (5.6%), "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (5.3%) "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (4.8%) and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (4.5%).

The consumer price index increased by 0.4 percent for January 2025. The point-topoint inflation rate stood at 1.9 percent due to relative price changes during the month of January 2025 compared with the same period in the previous year.


