

May 2025

The Consumer Price Index decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of May 2025 in comparison to an increase of 0.5 percent for the month of April 2025 (*see table 3*).

During the month of May 2025, the "All Items" index was registered at 129.8 in comparison to 129.9 for the month of April 2025. Three (3) groups recorded an increase during the month; "Transport" (1.7%), "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" (0.3%) and "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.1%). Two (2) groups recorded a decrease during the period; "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (1.2%) and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.1%). Seven (7) groups remained unchanged; "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages", "Clothing and Footwear", "Health", "Communication", "Recreation and Culture", "Education" and "Hotels and Restaurants".

The group index for "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" decreased by 1.2 percent on account of a 6.8 percent downward movement in the price of electricity. This decrease is due to a lower fuel surcharge rate which moved from 57.99 cents per kilowatt hour for the month of April 2025 to 50.63 cents per kilowatt hour for May 2025.

The index for the group "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" declined by 0.1 percent due to a reduction in the cost of mouthwash (1.1%) and toothpaste (1.0%).

The "Transport" index grew by 1.7 percent as a result of an increase in the price of diesel fuel (5.9%) and passenger airfare from St. Vincent and the Grenadines to several destinations which included Toronto, Canada (64.3%), London, United Kingdom (44.5%), St. Lucia (19.8%) and Miami, U.S.A, (9.7%).

The 0.3 increase in the group index for "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" is due to an increase in the price of imported beer (4.4%) and stout (0.7%).

"Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" group index grew by 0.1 percent due mainly to an increase in the price for dishwashing liquid (18.1%) and washing machine (4.6%).

Meanwhile, the group index for "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" remain unchanged even though there were price movements within the group. However, the prices that increased were similar to those that declined, hence the average change for the group is the same as the previous period.

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 0.5 percent for the month of May 2025 compared to 4.4 percent for the month of May 2024. The groups that represented the largest increases during the period were, "Education" (5.6%), "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (4.8%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (3.1%), "Health" (2.9%) and "Hotels and Restaurants" (2.8%).

The consumer price index decreased by 0.1 percent for May 2025. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 0.5 percent due to relative price changes during the month of May 2025 compared with the same period in the previous year.


