August 2025

The Consumer Price Index increased by 0.2 percent for the month of August similar to the increase of 0.2 percent for the month of July 2025 (*see table 3*).

During the month of August 2025, the "All Items" index was registered at 130.6 in comparison to 130.3 for the month of July 2025. Two (2) groups recorded an increase during the month; "Transport" (1.0%), and "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.5%). Four (4) groups recorded a decrease during the period; "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics" (0.2%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.2%), "Recreation and Culture" (0.2%), and "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.1%). Six (6) groups remained unchanged, "Clothing and Footwear", "Health", "Communication", "Education" and "Hotels and Restaurants" and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services".

The "Transport" group index recorded the largest increase of 1.0 percent. This was on account of increases in the price of brake fluid (6.3%), and passenger airfare from St. Vincent and the Grenadines to destinations such as: London (69.1%), Trinidad and Tobago (22.5%), and Antigua and Barbuda (14.7%).

Increased prices for food items such as frozen pigtail (10.9%), dasheen (7.4%), sweet potatoes (7.5%), eddoes (5.6%) and tannia (5.7%) were responsible for the 0.5 percent increase in the "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" index.

Meanwhile, the index for the group "Alcohol and Narcotics" fell by 0.2 percent due to a reduction in the cost of cigarettes (3.14%).

The group index "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" registered a 0.2 percent downward movement as a result of a reduction in the price of electricity consumption charge by 0.8 percent.

Similarly, the downward movement of 0.2 percent in the group index for Recreation and Culture" occurred due to a decrease in the price of an English textbook (11.2%).

Correspondingly, the "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" index fell by 0.1 percent due mainly to a decrease of 0.5 percent in the price for powdered detergent.

The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 1.6 percent for the month of August 2025 compared to 2.7 percent for the month of August 2024. The groups that represented the largest increases during the period were, "Education" (5.6%), "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (5.4%), "Hotels and Restaurants" (3.8%), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (3.7%) and "Clothing and Footwear" (2.2%).

The consumer price index increased by 0.2 percent for August 2025. The point-to-point inflation rate stood at 1.6 percent due to relative price changes during the month of August 2025 compared with the same period in the previous year.


